## What is SBIRT?

Screening, **B**rief **I**ntervention, and **R**eferral to **T**reatment (SBIRT) is an emerging standard of integrated care.

SBIRT **strengthens patient assessments** by effectively identifying each patient’s level of risk related to alcohol and drug use.

SBIRT provides an evidence-based framework to efficiently **address behavior change** with patients.
